## Casino Parties

For those of you who haven't experienced the #1 theme party in California, here is what you can expect:

**Excitement.** Experience the thrills of playing real casino games in a real casino atmosphere and have the chance to win real prizes. All this without any unpleasant side effects, such as losing large sums of money, which is unavoidable when gambling in Las Vegas, and often makes the experience an unpleasant one. Casino parties can be described as an "upbeat Vegas experience."

**Fantasy.** This is a theme party. We create the fantasy of being a "high roller" in Las Vegas, again without any unpleasant side effects.

**Heavy Participation.** Have no fear as to whether the casino will "go over" with your group. The games are fun and the excitement is irresistible. For those who don't know how to play, our dealers will explain the games in the simplest terms and make it fun for everyone.

**Compliments.** It's highly likely that once the party is over, people will be commenting that it was the best party that they have ever been to!

The scenario of the party is as follows:

The casino will be setup with your choice of several gaming tables. We offer Blackjack (21, the most popular casino game), Craps (dice), Roulette and Texas Hold 'Em poker.

Guests are given an amount of script (funny money) at the start of the party, except at "fund raisers." At fund raisers, depending on the particular situation, guests may purchase their funny money through the host of the party.

At the end of the party, chips are most often "cashed in" for raffle tickets in order to win prizes, usually given by the host of the party. Prizes are won

through raffle drawings. Even those players and guests that have \$5 left after 3 hours of gambling can participate in a raffle drawing. Another popular ending of the party is to have a “grand prize” winner that wins based on the total amount won.

The main difference between a casino party and Las Vegas is that players cannot “cash-in” their chips for cash or money. Instead, they win prizes with their chips. Also, you can expect the dealers to be a lot friendlier and helpful, since it’s a party!

Our goal is to offer the finest casino parties in the Bay Area...period! As you can see from the enclosed materials, we have put a lot of effort towards that goal...in the professionalism of our dealers, equipment and coordination of the party.

Our consistent high performance is no accident. We have an extremely organized operation with many built-in safeguards to ensure that our performance will be perfect in every way. The following is a guideline as to significant concerns that we take very seriously about a casino party.

### **Hiring the Right People**

All dealers must apply in writing. Their application includes information about their educational background, casino experience and how they enjoy their free time. If acceptable, they are invited to our training class where they are taught to deal “Las Vegas” style, but in a friendlier manner. They are given a training manual for each game they are trained on and are tested on actual dealing performance using the actual equipment for the parties.

### **Behavior of Dealers at a Party**

This subject may seem unnecessary, but is one of the biggest problems in this industry. The problem seems to result from the fact that when the dealers arrive at the location, it is natural for them to relate more to the guests than to the “help.”

To prevent any problems in this area, we have a written set of dealer standards for behavior. See “Dealer Standards” attached.

### **Casino Ready to Begin on Time**

Problems can always arise during set-up or on the way to the party location. To ensure that we are always set up on time, we do 2 things that are significant, in addition to always being generous with the number of people and hours assigned to the job.

1. Our set up timetable allows for extra time from the end of the setup until the beginning of the party whenever possible. Normally this time is used for the setup crew to eat dinner and change clothes, but can be used to finish setup in case of an emergency.
2. We pay our dealers to arrive 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the casino start time for 3 reasons:
  - a. We have a dealer meeting and explain the particulars of the party
  - b. Provide an allowance for dealers getting lost or being delayed
  - c. Give the customer the flexibility to start a little early if desired

## **Dealer Standards**

The following guidelines represent a standard of conduct for our dealers. Generally speaking, they represent minimum standards for hotel employees. Many parties are in hotels and we need to look as professional as the hotel staff.

### **Do's and Don'ts at a Party**

- No tip jars
- No liquor at any time, even if offered by the host or customer. Soft drinks and water are OK. Soft drinks are never guaranteed to be available or as part of your pay
- No food at any time, even if offered by the host or customer
- No cups of coffee at the Blackjack tables
- No gum chewing while dealing
- No smoking at tables. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas
- No sitting at tables or on stools, even if your table is empty
- Be ready to start the game play by standing behind your table, facing the party area
- Do not take your shoes off
- No cheating for players
- Do not give out any free chips
- Be on time. You are expected to arrive at the party location 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the casino opening. Allow time for traffic delays, parking and finding the party location.

## **Dress Requirements**

- Dealers are to be well groomed, nails clean, shirts pressed, shoes polished
- No pants or skirts made out of: leather, jean material, corduroy, shiny or satin material, stretch material, etc.
- No clip-on ties, suspenders or white socks
- No excessive jewelry (large necklaces, chains, pearls, fancy belts)
- Hair trimmed and neat
- Proper fitting tuxedo shirts, altered if needed for proper fit in sleeves
- Enter and leave the party with your tie on
